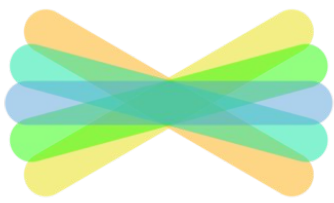

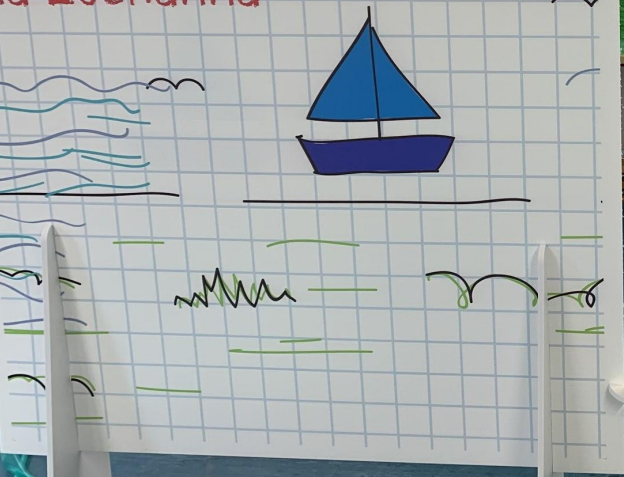

Dealing with a suspected case of Covid-19

Pupils should not attend school if displaying any symptoms of Covid-19. If a pupil displays symptoms of Covid-19 while in the building, the following are the procedures will be implemented:

Inform Parents

Isolate and look after child

Home

Medical Advice

Follow HSE procedures

TCP- PPE

gloves, face masks, hand sanitizer gel (some non- alcoholic), thermometers, aprons , wipes, paper towels, push pedal bins, blue rolls, detergents, sprays for desktops, etc for use around the school as appropriate.

Children who should not attend school

If your child is in one of the following categories, they should not attend school –

- Children who have been diagnosed with Covid-19
- Children who have been in close contact with a person who has been diagnosed with Covid-19
- Children who have a suspected case of Covid-19 and the outcome of the test is pending
- Children who have been in contact with a person who has a suspected case of Covid-19 and the outcome of the test is pending
- Children with underlying health conditions who have been directed by a medical professional not to attend school
- Children who have returned home after travelling abroad and must self-isolate for a period of 14 days
- Children who are generally unwell (Cough, fever, runny nose, vomiting, sore throat, diarrhoea)

If a child is not able to attend school for an extended period of time, the class teacher (and/or the learning support teacher, where relevant) suggested activities to support the child's learning at home will be shared with parents.
